2	Common non-compliance findings following pre-assessment and rating visits The ESB explained that since the introduction of pre-assessment and rating visits of services previously rated under the 2012 National Quality Standards (NQS), there has been a reduction in services being rated as 'Working Towards the NQS'. Mr. Heffernan explained that while this is a positive trend, there are common areas of non-compliance being identified, being: • Medication management • Emergency evacuations The Roundtable discussed common reasons why non-compliance is found	Sean Heffernan	
	<ul> <li>The Roundtable discussed common reasons why non-compliance is found with medication management, including generic medication being provided over name-brand or as prescribed by the children or young persons medical practitioner.</li> <li>The Roundtable also discussed reasons why non-compliance is being found with emergency evacuations with the ESBs position being that all services must undertake an emergency evacuation and invacuation rehearsal within every three-month period.</li> </ul>
